The KAMES Community Amenities

Living in the KAMES provides a worry-free environment regarding maintenance of the units. The annual maintenance fee, usually paid in monthly installments, is allocated between an Operating Fund and a Reserve Fund.

Disbursements from the Operating Fund provide for:

- Lawn mowing & trimming
- Weekly trash pickup
- Snow and ice removal
- Fertilizer and weed control
- Annual window washing
- Trimming of trees, shrubs & bushes
- Landscaping of Common ElementsLeaf and debris removal
- Casualty and liability insurance
- Insect and rodent control
- Periodic mulch
- Cable TV (about 70 channels) *Note: The Cable TV contract will expire on September 30, 2019. There are no plans to renew it.*
- Maintenance of:
 - o Mail boxes
 - \circ Ponds
 - o Retaining walls
 - Fences and railings

- o Free standing lampposts
- o Utility lines, pipes and facilities
- o Driveways and walkways
- o Repair and sealing of roads

Disbursements from the Reserve Fund provide for the replacement of the following items:

- Roofs including gutters and downspouts
- Garage doors
- Siding, i.e., exterior of the unit except windows and skylights
- Soffit and fascia
- Repaving roads (there is approximately one mile of private roads within the Kames).
- Decks, patios, gazebo's & balconies
- Structural walls & foundations
- Entry doors, frames, sills, sashes & thresholds
- Porch enclosures
- Outside steps and railings

The heated pool is open from Memorial Day to after Labor Day, and there is a clubhouse that is used for Association functions or Unit Owners may use for private activities.
